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Fuel Hazards

- Grass, Woodpiles, Sagebrush, Dead Tree Species: Juniper, Pine, Aspen
- Thick crown cover in some areas
- Surrounding area consists of: Hay Meadows, Sagebrush, Gravel Pit, Highway, State Trust Land, Private Land.

Homes/Businesses/Infrastructure

Businesses

- Ranches
- Never Summer Studio (Patsy Barry)

Roads

- All Roads are Gravel
- Bordering Highway (HWY 14) Paved
- 2 normal car traffic lanes in subdivision
- 1 Large vehicle traffic lane in subdivision
- One Cul-de-sac
- Most have adequate turn-around space for emergency vehicles

Driveways

- Few/Some have adequate turn-around space for emergency vehicles
- Few have posted addressing

Homes

- All are wood/log structures
- None have wood decks or porches
- All have stone decks or porches
- All have metal roofing material
- Some are visible from main road

Other Infrastructure

- Bridges: None
- Gates: None are locked, All are wide enough for emergency equipment

- Culverts: All support emergency equipment
- Cattle Guards: All support emergency equipment

Utilities

- All Utilities below ground
- Poor Cellular phone service
- All houses have landlines
- Few to none use propane, no above ground tanks
- No natural Gas use

Water

- All houses have wells
- There are four ponds, one (HOA) pond has a dry hydrant

Other Community Values at Risk

- Main Ranch Buildings, Historic House/Barn
- Lookouts
- Bird/Sagegrouse habitat
- Other wildlife habitat

Emergency Preparedness

- NO current evacuation plan
- Response Time: 15 minutes from Gould; 30 minutes from Walden
- Insurance Rating: ??????

Priorities

- Removal of Dead/Dying Conifer
- D-Space to structures (most are in compliance)
- Individual Evacuation Plans
- Share information and escape routes throughout the community.
