

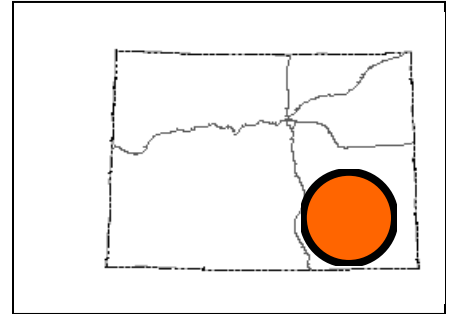

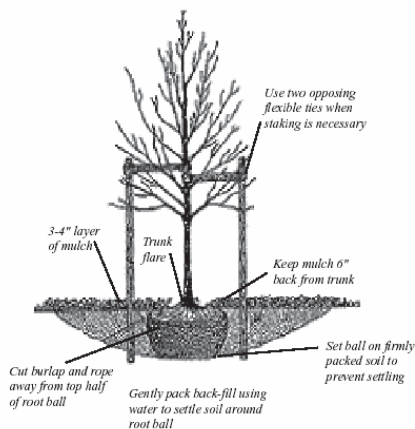

A key change for this book includes species recommendations unique to Southeast Colorado. Since funds were limited to produce the book two sponsors
