#### ***Insect and Disease Protocol:***

- 🌿 Carefully observe the tree and it's environment
- 🌿 Look for anything unusual or out of the ordinary
- 🌿 Take photos of your tree and the landscape where the tree is
- 🌿 Take a photo of just the tree from 2 or more sides
- 🌿 Take photos of the affected tree parts
- 🌿 Take close-up shots of anything that looks wrong or suspicious, like an insect or discoloration of leaves, needles, branches or bark
- 🌿 Take as many photos as you'd like
- 🌿 You can send in a zip file, or multiple emails if you wish

#### ***Information that will be helpful to know and to include:***

- 🌿 Watering habits
- 🌿 Pesticide or herbicide use
- 🌿 Mowing or weed whip usage near base of trunk
- 🌿 Animal presence, such as deer, rabbits or rodents
- 🌿 Your contact information for follow-up

Remember, the more information you can share, the easier it will be to determine what is happening with your tree(s).
