In the aftermath of destructive wildfires, reforesting burned land helps protect water supplies, restores wildlife habitat, and reduces flooding and erosion. You can help restore our forests by donating to the Restoring Colorado's Forests fund, established in 2003 to provide seedling trees that will be planted on lands most severely impacted by wildfires and other disasters.

Seedling trees are grown at the Colorado State Forest Service Nursery on the CSU Foothills Campus, where our experts make sure only high-quality trees adapted to local conditions are used in forest restoration efforts.

Your donation will be used to pay for seedlings that will be planted on state and private land. Every \$2 donation will purchase one seedling that will be given free of charge to qualified applicants whose land has been devastated by wildfires. Areas deemed most critical to water protection and wildlife habitat – and that provide the most public benefit – will be targeted for planting efforts.

Your generous donation will help seed Colorado forests for present and future generations to enjoy.
